Dear Parents and Guardians

Further to the Premier's announcement this morning that we will not be going into lockdown, I write to confirm the restrictions which John Septimus Roe Anglican Community School (JSRACS) must enforce over the coming week, with details as to how these restrictions will be managed by the School.

The restrictions impacting JSRACS include the following:

- Wearing of masks,
- Size restrictions on gatherings and,
- Continuing signing in protocols (for contact tracing).

### Wearing of Masks

The expectation remains that all staff and students (Years 7 – 12) must wear a mask, indoors and outdoors.

The same protocols for mask wearing at JSRACS remain, as were detailed in my letter dated 26 April 2021.

### Signing in Protocols

It will still be required of all parents and visitors to sign in at the School by using the SafeWA App and QR code sign-in or the manual sign-in registers at the School.

### Size Restrictions on Gatherings

There is currently a transitional restriction which states that all gatherings return to pre-lockdown restrictions, other than the requirement for all visitors to wear a mask.

The week's Parent Information sessions - Armed For Life (Tuesday, 4 May 7:00pm – 8:00pm) and the Year 10 Parent Information Night (Wednesday, 5 May 7:00pm – 8:30pm) will proceed as planned.

This current restriction is also great news for our planned Mothers' Day Breakfasts at both campuses, as we are not expecting more than 500 parents and guardians to attend either event, so they may proceed as planned. I would like to stress, however, that masks must be worn at all times, other than when eating or drinking.

This also means that the School can reinstate all Assemblies with parental attendance; however, please note the requirements that all visitors must be wearing their masks and sign in, as detailed above.

As always, we will continue to monitor the WA position in relation to COVID-19 and schooling. We are ready to adapt as the situation changes and will keep you informed as new information is made available.
