Dear Parents and Guardians

This evening, the WA Premier, Mr Mark McGowan, announced a four-day lockdown for the Perth and Peel Regions, commencing 12:00am Tuesday, 29 June 2021 and ending 12:01am Saturday, 3 July 2021. The Premier's announcement included a statement highlighting that all schools would remain open for the four-day lockdown.

The School's Executive Team met this evening and confirmed the following information specific to John Septimus Roe Anglican Community School.

Staff will be onsite over the next four days and students may attend school as normal, with all current Phase 1 restrictions in place throughout the lockdown period.

All elements of the School's normal onsite operations, such as co-curricular activities and after-school events, other than school sporting events, will still be offered.

Out of School Care Service

The School's Out of School Care Service will operate as normal and will be available to all children as usual, and as have been booked.

Wearing of Masks, Social Distancing and the SafeWA App

Parents must be vigilant in wearing their masks to drop off and pick up their children. Social distancing protocols must always be strictly adhered to.

All visitors to the School must continue to sign in using the SafeWA App or the manual sign in registers.

Kindergarten – Year 12 Curriculum

The Kindergarten to Year 12 curriculum will not be delivered to students over the four-day lockdown remotely. JSRACS staff will only deliver the curriculum in one mode, that being onsite delivery only.

CareerLink Students

Specific information will be communicated to all CareerLink students regarding their work placements and online options through their Registered Training Organisations.

Excursions, Incursions, Camps and Events

All excursions, incursions, camps and events planned for this week will be postponed or cancelled. Further information will be communicated to all relevant parents throughout the week.

As always, we continue to monitor the WA position in relation to COVID-19 and schooling very closely, and are ready to adapt as the situation changes. Please be assured that we will continue to keep you updated over the coming days.
