Dear Parents and Guardians

Further to the comments made this morning by the Minister for Education, Ms Sue Ellery, at the 11:00am COVID-19 Government briefing, there are to be no external visitors to schools for the rest of this week.

In this regard, John Septimus Roe Anglican Community School will revert to its former Drop-Off and Pick-Up Protocols, as are detailed below.

### Drop-Off and Pick-Up Protocols

The School will require parents of Pre-Primary to Year 12 students to drop their children at the designated drop-off points at the commencement of each school day. Students may then access the School independently or will be chaperoned by staff onto the school site.

Parents will also be required to pick their children up from the designated pick-up areas at the end of each school day.

I would like to confirm that parents must not access the school site at drop-off or pick-up times. This protocol is actioned immediately.

Please note that Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten parents are still able to drop their children off at their classrooms; however, they will need to use the SafeWA App. Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten parents are not to enter the classrooms; rather, their children will be chaperoned into their classrooms by staff.

While I understand the inconvenience this restriction places on parents, accentuated by the timing of its expectation, please note that the implementation of the pick-up and drop-off protocols is a direct response to the current COVID-19 Lockdown and Western Australia's effort to curb the spread of the highly transmissible Delta variant of this virus.
