John Septimus Roe Anglican Community School is pleased to offer the below scholarships which provide for the part remission of tuition fees for Years 7 to 12 from 2023:

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP (up to 10 Scholarships available)

Awarded to up to 10 Students entering Year 7 2023 at John Septimus Roe Anglican Community School (JSRACS). Current JSRACS students in Year 6, 2022 as well as students studying at a School other than JSRACS may apply. These Scholarships provide for up to 50% remission of tuition fees at JSRACS for Year 7, 2023 through to Year 12, 2028.

ACADEMIC TESTING

All applicants will be required to sit the Schools selection of Academic Scholarship testing papers. All applicants will be required to pay the JSRACS School application fee to sit the test.

Results of the testing will be only one factor of consideration when awarding Academic Scholarships.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD

These Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the Principal by recommendation from the Scholarship Committee. Successful candidates must demonstrate a high level of academic achievement, continue to maintain involvement in the Gifted and Talented programs and make a positive contribution to the School.

The Scholarship are awarded on the condition that the recipient will finish their secondary education at JSRACS. Should a Scholarship recipient leave the School prior to graduation that may be required to return the financial award of the Scholarship to the School.

The continuation of the Scholarship throughout the year is subject to the recipient making good academic progress, displaying conduct of the highest standard and contributing to the life of the School through participation in leadership and other co-curricular activities.

Academic Scholarships will be reviewed where it is considered a student is not striving for their academic potential. This will be based on a range of assessments conducted as part of the teaching and learning program.

INTERVIEWS

Shortlisted applicants will be contacted to attend an interview with the Principal and the Scholarship Committee. Parents and scholarship applicants will have the opportunity to tour the school facilities and meet with Senior staff and or student leaders.
