



TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS FOR YEAR 7 ORIENTATION DAY

FRIDAY 28 OCTOBER 2022

Private Vehicle

If you are driving your child to the Mirrabooka Campus for their Orientation Day then it is essential that you drop them off in the designated Year 7-12 drop off and pick-up area at the back of the school (refer to enclosed Map).

To access this area you need enter from Mirrabooka Avenue, proceed around the roundabout on the internal road, turn left after the oval and proceed to the Secondary set down and collection area; as indicated, adjacent to the hard courts. There will be a staff member in this area to direct those students who are unsure where to go. Proceed around the roundabout to exit via the traffic lights at Mirrabooka Avenue or continue south to the Thyme Court Exit.

At the end of the day, students can return to the pick-up point near the hard courts and safely wait here under staff supervision until 4pm. Remember that the school day does not finish until 3:30pm and students will take time to get to the pick-up area.

As we are trying to make this day as similar as possible to next year, students do not need to be escorted to the gymnasium by parents. There is no parking available for parents.

Transperth Bus

Students need to have a 'smartrider card' to utilise the concession fare, otherwise students can pay cash. Credit for use on the Transperth system cannot be made at school. Value to the card can be added by paying any bus driver (minimum \$10), by phone or internet using BPay or at Add-value machines located at train stations. Private School Bus

On Orientation Day (28 October) there will be a bus specifically for current Year 6 students which will travel non-stop from Beechboro Campus to Mirrabooka Campus in the morning and non-stop return in the afternoon. Students wishing to utilise this service need to return the tear-off slip or complete the Forms link on the information letter included in this package. A member of staff will be present at both campuses to direct the students both in the morning and the afternoon.
