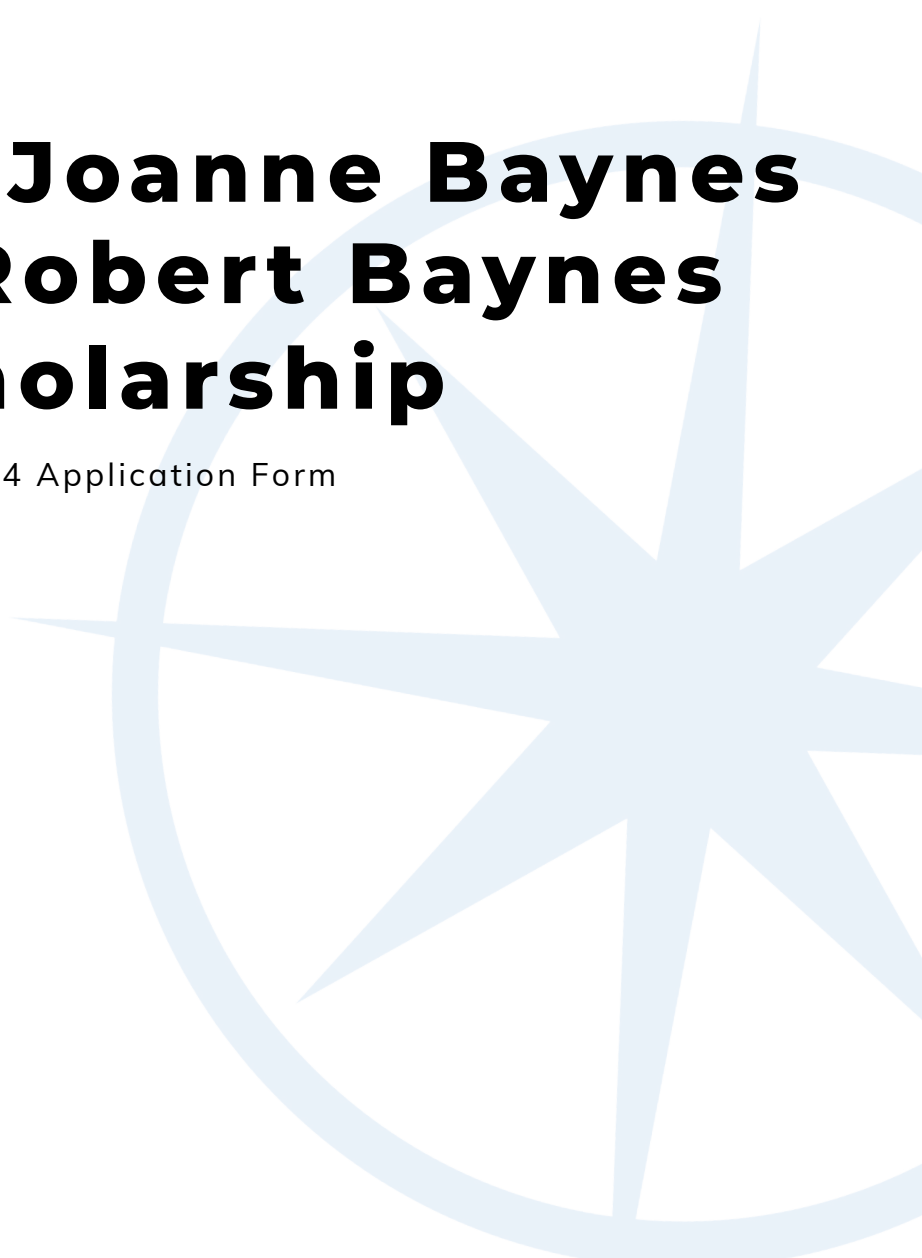
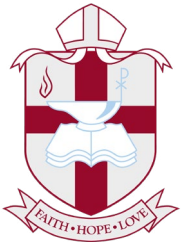

- Alternatively, applicants for these Scholarships may choose to bring in the appropriate records, if called for, at the time of their interview (see below).

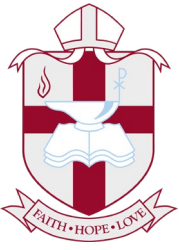

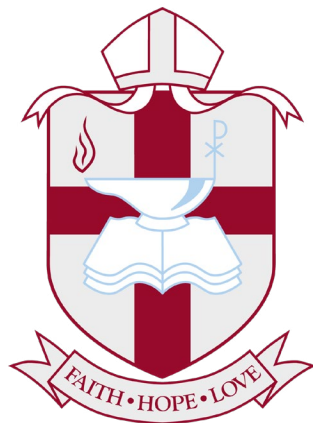
