FEE SCHEDULE

TUITION FEES – 1 JANUARY 2026

Kindergarten (5 full days per week)	\$5,460 annually
Pre-Primary to Year 2	\$5,680 annually
Year 3 to Year 6	\$6,180 annually
Year 7 to Year 9	\$8,760 annually
Year 10 to Year 12 (textbooks for Year 11 & 12 not included)	\$9,180 annually

Students in Kindergarten to Year 6 are required to pay an additional amount for consumable items, being \$75 for Early Learning Years and \$125 for Years 2-6 in place of a booklist

The fees for students in Year 7 through to Year 10 include textbooks.

School fees are set and charged as an annual fee. However, we do provide several payment options to support our families with managing their payments over the year as shown below. Year 12 fees are charged at the same annual fee level.

Pre-Kindergarten families are billed on a termly basis for the number of sessions per term, each session being three hours which equates to half a day.

Pre-Kindergarten – Half Day (1 session)	\$41.00 per half day
Pre-Kindergarten – Full Day (2 sessions on the same day)	\$82.00 per full day

SIBLING DISCOUNTS

The discounts on the tuition fees apply at the rate of: -

- 20% for the second sibling,
- 30% third sibling,
- 50% fourth sibling,
- 100% for fifth and subsequent siblings

The discounts on tuition fees are available for families with two or more siblings in the School at one time and with one fee account.

CAPITAL LEVY (GST free)

1 Child at JSRACS \$360 per year

2 or more Children \$570 per year

This levy operates to help fund the building program of the School. Levy funds are used only for Capital purposes.

PARENTS AND FRIENDS ASSOCIATION LEVY \$95 (GST free)

All parents are automatically members of the Parents and Friends Association. The P&F Association exists to provide fellowship and fundraising opportunities for parents as members of the school community. An annual compulsory levy of \$95 per family is charged which is used for the purchase of equipment and items for the School and for Association expenses.

Capital Levy and Parents and Friends Levy are annual charges and there is no pro rata adjustment for enrolment for part of the year.

REGISTRATION OF INTEREST IN ENROLMENT FEE \$40

A non-refundable \$40 Registration Fee is payable on submission of a Registration of Interest in Enrolment form. The submission of a Registration of Interest in Enrolment form does not constitute an offer of enrolment.

OFFER OF ENROLMENT ACCEPTANCE FEE

A non-refundable Acceptance Fee is due and payable to secure your child's place at JSRACS. This fee is not deducted from the first term's tuition fees. The Acceptance Fee for the first child is currently \$900, \$500 for a second child, \$200 for a third child and \$100 for any subsequent child. These fees apply to children enrolled for the same family and are payable at the time of acceptance of an enrolment place offered in the School.

OUT OF SCHOOL CARE FEES

Out of School Care is offered to all enrolled students from Pre-Kindergarten to Year 6.

Monday - Friday (7.00 - 8.30am and 3.30 - 6.00pm) during school term time and Vacation Care is offered during school vacation periods (7.00am - 6.00pm). Details of the fees are contained in a separate brochure.

MUSIC TUITION

Students may choose to learn a particular musical instrument during school time. Private tutors are available. Music lesson fees are billed by the School separately at the end of each term in accordance with the guidelines outlined in SEQTA. Please contact the School Office for further information. Family fees must be up to date to continue with music tuition.

SCHOOL TRIPS and TOURS

Family fees must be paid in full or all regular payments up to date by the time the last tour payment is made for a student to attend a tour. Should fees not be paid and your payments up to date, any tour funds will be credited to family fees and attendance on the tour will be forfeited.

PAYMENT OPTIONS FOR TUITION FEES

You may choose to pay your account:

- In full by 20 February 2026 and receive a 2% discount.
- Half by 20 February 2026 and the remainder by 20 July 2026.
- A quarter by 20 February 2026, 20 May 2026, 20 August 2026 and 20 November 2026.
- A monthly payment from 20 February 2026 - 20 November 2026 (10 payments)
- A fortnightly payment from 20 February 2026 - 20 November 2026 (20 payments)

Parents who are unable to pay fees by the due date must make alternative payment arrangements by contacting the Accounts office.

Payment of fees can be made via BPAY®, EFTPOS, Direct Debit, the online portal or Mastercard and Visa card.

For card payment only this can be arranged by contacting the Accounts office via email to fees@jsracs.wa.edu.au

Please note, legal action for recovery of outstanding fees is taken when school fees remain overdue. Costs including commissions, fees and legal expenses are payable by the parent or guardian.

FEE CONCESSIONS

The School is always mindful of parents with genuine financial needs who require reduced fees. Parents seeking fee concessions must complete a confidential application form and attend an interview with the Business Manager or delegate. Concessions are negotiated on an annual basis. Application forms are available on request from the Accounts office. Fee concessions are not ongoing and are utilised for enrolled families experiencing short-term financial hardship.

BANK FEES

In the event of there being insufficient funds to make payments by one of the above-mentioned methods, then fees from banks and other institutions charged to John Septimus Roe Anglican Community School will be recovered from parents at the current rate of \$5.00 per transaction.

SECONDARY ASSISTANCE SCHEME

Families who hold a Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card are eligible for up to \$535 towards school expenses through the Government's Secondary Assistance Scheme. Of this, up to \$300 is paid direct to the parent as a clothing allowance and \$235 is paid to the school to go towards school fees. Parents/students can obtain application forms or further information from the Main Reception. Application forms are required to be submitted prior to the end of Term One each year.
