Primary School iPad Code of Conduct Agreement

The following is an agreement that relates specifically to the JSR BYOD iPad Programme. It sits alongside the School ICT Acceptable Use Policy outlined in the student diary and should be read in that context. By enrolling their iPad into the School's AirWatch MDM System, parents and students are signifying that they are aware of their responsibilities when using devices on the school network and in the classroom.

The student agrees to the following:

Digital Etiquette

*The **standards** of conduct expected by digital technology users*

The following is a list of the requirements a students need to understand and accept when using their iPads at school. A student must:

1. Follow all teacher directions including when to use the device.
2. Have the volume of devices muted at the beginning of each lesson.
3. Use appropriate manners when communicating electronically.
4. Provide their device to teachers upon request.
5. Provide their device to parents upon request.

Digital Access & Use

*Full **electronic** participation in society*

A student is required to:

1. Utilise access to various communications offered by the School in an appropriate and safe manner.
2. Bring their iPad fully charged to School every day.
3. Maintain and clean their device, and keep their iPad in its case at all times.
4. Take care when carrying their iPads between any classes.
5. Report any damage immediately to their parents.
6. Inform the teacher or others when using the camera and audio recording functions and are reminded that they must **not** publish photographs or video to any online network.
7. Only access their device during lunchtime under the instruction and supervision of a teacher, and not loan their device to another student or leave it in such a place that it is likely to be stolen.
8. Only access appropriately rated applications, movies and music and only use their own Apple IDs for this purpose.
9. enrol their device into the AirWatch MDM System and NOT remove any enrolment profiles.

As part of the School ensuring a duty of care, students and families are not permitted to:

1. Change their Apple ID's without prior discussion with the school.
2. JailBreak their device under any circumstances.
3. Bring 3G/4G Sim Cards to School (if their iPad supports these).

Digital Health & Wellbeing

*The **elements** of physical and psychological well-being related to digital technology use*

A balance between the use of digital technologies and physical activities is essential.

1. Students must commit to a healthy lifestyle by using mobile devices only when relevant during the school day.
2. Students must commit to a balance of the use of the device at home.

Loss or Damage

In the event of loss, theft or damage while at school, this must be reported to the class teacher. Parents are strongly encouraged to ensure that their iPads are covered within their home and contents insurance policy for accidental damage
